**December:** No meeting. Come to the November meeting to discuss a community outreach initiative for the holiday season.

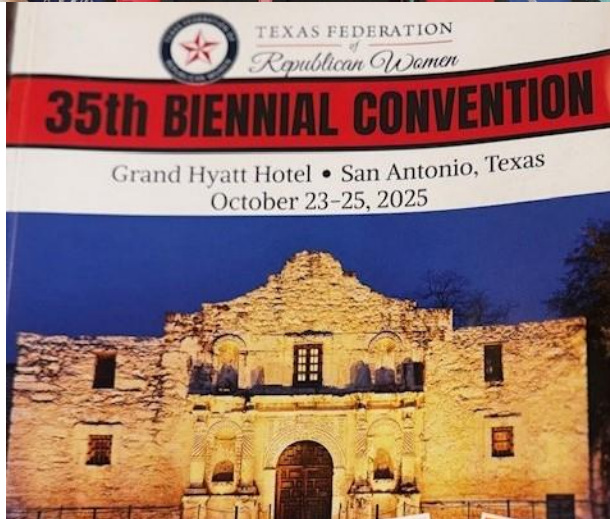


## TFRW Biennial Convention Recap— You Won't Want to Miss the Next One!
